

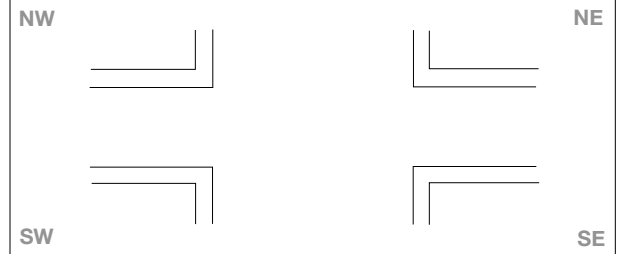

13. Are there any audio tones (or other accommodations) for blind people?		
14. Are there any obstructions or gouges in intersection crosswalks?		
15. Are there any obstructions on sidewalks (in the crosswalk area)?		
16. Do all corners in the intersection have curb cut(s)?		
17. Are any curb cuts built up with asphalt?		
18. Do the curb cuts meet the street evenly?		
19. Are the curb cuts within the marked crosswalk?		
20. Is the curb cut the width of the crosswalk?		
21. Is there room for two wheel chairs, strollers, etc. on the curb cut (64")?		
22. Is there room for one wheel chair, stroller, etc. on the curb cut (32")?		
23. Are the curb cuts aligned with adjacent curb cuts?		
24. Do all curb cuts have grooves for traction?		
25. Are all the curb cuts at the intersection easily navigable by wheel chair, stroller, etc.?		
26. If no, are any of the curb cuts navigable by wheel chair, stroller, etc. with difficulty?		
27. If no, are any of the curb cuts not navigable by wheel chair?
